

Atlanta Academy's Summer Reading Olympics 2008

We are proud to announce that our students in grades K-5 will have the chance to participate in the Atlanta Academy's fifth annual Summer Reading Olympics. Our goal is to motivate our students to read throughout the summer.

Again this year, we are asking students and parents to record how many minutes are spent reading. Using the attached form, our Reading Olympians can earn a gold medal for reading for 1,000 minutes over the summer (that is about 20 minutes a day for four days a week over the summer), 700 minutes for the silver (that is about 20 minutes a day for three days a week over the summer), and 500 minutes for the bronze (that is 20 minutes twice a week over the summer). Please remember to include the minutes that the students are read to or listen to a story on tape!

The Media Center page under 'Teacher Websites' also has grade appropriate reading lists for all grades to help your Olympian make great selections on his quest for the gold!
